Brief Description of the Approval Granted by Competent Authority	<p>With reference to the indent No. INS/L-5832/2021-22, received for the procurement of Data storage of 20 Nos. quantity with an estimated value of Rs. 11,30,000/- with respect to Budget Code 8030(Core Grant), action was initiated from Purchase section to process the RFP through Gem Portal on 12-05-2022 with GeM Bid Ref No. GEM/2022/B/2173287, and one firm has participated, and the bid was opened and forwarded to indenter for technical recommendations. The indenter has recommended that the quoted specifications by M/s. Shopsy Store Pvt. Ltd is not matching with tender specifications and the firm is technically disqualified. Further, indenter recommended that since the indented items are spares and accessories for the existing equipment which is under warranty and the items being proposed are spares to be procured from the OEM i.e., DDN through authorised distributors/OEM directly and the quoted items by M/s. Shopsy Store Pvt. Ltd would be void as these HDD's may not work with the existing 6TB HDD's and may damage the configured setup, and the idea is to retain the setup as it is and scale up the storage capacity for smooth functionality. Further with recommendations received at page N/4 from indenter stating that present system warranty would be void if the HDD's certified by the DDN are not installed to the existing storage appliance. Hence, it is proposed to release a new RFP with MII as option 'NO'. Since no supplier technically qualified against the bid processed through GeM as an MII product, it is proposed to upgrade the Data Storage through GeM as a non MII product to receive more competitive bids from the suppliers in GeM portal.</p>

### Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

#### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

#### 2. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods

#### 3. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 1 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

#### 4. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. Warranty Should be minimum One year or more and as per OEM Standards.
2. After adding drives to existing setup the support should be considered for entire unit and not only for the parts.
3. Installation and Configuration should be done without reconfiguring existing setup.
4. Necessary Cables should be included as per requirement.

## **Disclaimer**

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations. Also, GeM does not permit collection of Tender fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction as the case may be. Any stipulation by the Buyer seeking payment of Tender Fee / Auction fee through ATC clauses would be treated as null and void.
