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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as per procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notified by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier shall be as per the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the bidder stating the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with the declaration that no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) Order dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be eligible to participate. In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same shall have precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are not eligible for the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in the form of L-1. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price. The lowest price will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or impact on price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

Essential Conditions of Contract

1. All the joints and tapings in the tubing lines of pressurized gas system shall have to be done mainly using oxygen welding. For some places where welding is practically not possible, compression tube fittings can be used of approved make.

All the connectors and joints must be Teflon tape/glue free.

2. All the systems shall be pressure tested minimum 1.5 to 2 times the working pressure, which shall be witnessed by qualified Engineers. Leaks, if any, shall be arrested and the system shall be subjected for standard test once again. A test certificate shall be issued after successful test for each section of tubing and whole system.

3. All the items used, works carried out and the testing shall be confirming to the latest and relevant standard.

4. The equipment and materials used shall be of approved make.

5. The contractor should ensure implementation of best safety procedures and precautions while working at construction site. The safety of equipment, staff and materials used by the contractor shall be the whole responsibility of the contractor. Contractor is responsible for this.

6. Contractor is responsible for meeting all the statutory and safety norms in this nature of work.

7. Different gas systems shall be suitably color coded as per standard practice and all the lines shall be labeled along with directional flow marking.
